Service Arrangement of 18 CMCTRs under Adverse Weather

In response to the Hong Kong Observatory's announcement that Super Typhoon Ragasa is gradually approaching Hong Kong, the services of 18 Chinese Medicine Clinics cum Training and Research Centres (CMCTRs) will be suspended from today (23 September 2025) afternoon, and during the period when Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above, "Extreme Condition" or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force. The appointment function of this mobile application will also be suspended. Patients should avoid visiting the CMCTRs during the storm or adverse weather conditions for the sake of safety.

In general, the services of 18 CMCTRs will be resumed in 2 hours after the warning signal No. 8, "Extreme Condition" or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is cancelled, or in the next consultation session. The appointment service will be also gradually resumed. The 18 CMCTRs will assess the clinic environmental safety and make corresponding arrangements based on the weather condition.
