

Supporting Residents of Tai Po Wang Fuk Court
With Government-subsidised Chinese Medicine Outpatient Services
Fee Waivers Arrangement

The Government announced on 1 December 2025 providing medical fee waivers and various support measures for the residents affected by the fire incident at Wang Fuk Court in Tai Po. From 2 December 2025, the 18 Chinese Medicine Clinic cum Training and Research Centres (CMCTRs) provide full medical fee waiving of the Government-subsidised Chinese Medicine Outpatient Services to all residents (including foreign domestic helpers) of Wang Fuk Court until 31 December 2026. Services cover general consultation (with a maximum of 5 doses of CM products), acupuncture and bone-setting/tui-na (at some of the clinics). Eligible persons can make the appointment by calling individual CMCTR during service hours, (refer to the table below) or through the “18 CM Clinics” mobile application (applicable to patients who have registered for 18 CMCTRs service before).

Patients shall identify themselves as Wang Fuk Court residents to CMCTRs at registration and provide basic personal information (including name, identity document number and address) and sign the “Declaration Form” (applicable for patients’ first consultation at each CMCTR) for registration.

Moreover, regarding the Integrated Chinese-Western Medicine (ICWM) service at hospitals / day care centres / outpatient clinics at Hospital Authority (HA) (currently six designated disease areas), the corresponding service fee would also be waived for the eligible persons who fulfill the ICWM programme criteria.

Note: The personal information collected from “Declaration Form” is only used for handling the medical fee waiver arrangement. The HA will disclose such information to the relevant Government departments for verification purpose. In any case that the provision of incomplete, inaccurate, out-of-date, false or misleading information by way of declaration may result in revocation of waiving of medical fees and/or criminal prosecution. The HA will also pass the case to relevant Government departments for handling. Any medical fees waived prior to revocation shall be recoverable as a debt repayable on demand.
